SUMMARY AND AUTHORIZATION

Adirondack Park Agency Permit 2022-0155 authorized the replacement and re-location of 10 utility pole structures and activities involving wetlands. This permit amends Permit 2022-0155, as conditioned below, to allow additional temporary impacts to wetlands resulting from construction access for Pole 57.

The amendment authorized herein is shown on Page 2 of the "Erosion and Sediment Control Plan, Figure 7," prepared by LaBella and dated May 2023 (Page 2). A reduced-scale copy of the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan is attached as a part of this permit for easy reference. The original, full-scale maps and plans described in this paragraph are the official plans for the project, with copies available upon request from Adirondack Park Agency headquarters in Ray Brook, New York.

This permit amendment does not convey any right to trespass upon the lands or interfere with the riparian rights of others in order to undertake the authorized project, nor does it authorize the impairment of any easement, right, title or interest in real or personal property.

Nothing contained in this permit amendment shall be construed to satisfy any legal obligations of the permittee to comply with all applicable laws and regulations or to obtain any governmental approval or permit from any entity other than the Agency, whether federal, State, regional or local.

PROJECT SITE

The project site is a 0.61-mile section of existing utility line located within the NYSDOT highway right-of-way of Route 28 in the Town of Arietta, Hamilton County and is located adjacent to lands classified as Wilderness, Wild Forest, and Intensive Use on the Adirondack Park Land Use and Development Plan Map.

CONDITIONS

- 1. Condition 9 of Permit 2022-0155 is hereby amended to authorize the additional temporary impacts to wetlands for access to Pole 57 in the location shown and as depicted on the Erosion and Sediment Control. Any change to the location, dimensions, or other aspect of the authorized activities shall require prior written Agency authorization.
 - All other terms and conditions in Permit 2022-0155 remain in full force and effect.
- 2. This permit amendment shall be recorded in the Hamilton County Clerk's Office within 60 days of the date of its issuance.
- 3. All deeds conveying all or a portion of the lands subject to this permit shall contain references to this permit amendment as follows: "The lands conveyed are subject to Adirondack Park Agency Permit 2022-0155A, issued May 18, 2023, the conditions of which are binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the grantors and all subsequent grantees."


