Three enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **January 2013** as follows:

SETTLEMENTS OF SUBDIVISION VIOLATIONS (2)

These settlements authorize the illegal lots involved in each case, allocate principal building rights, require a permit for future land use or development as appropriate, and require the filing of the settlement in the county clerk's office.

Other Violations (1)

• E2012-0008, Zelinski (Piercefield, St. Lawrence County) Construction of a road in a wetland to access a proposed single family dwelling site without the necessary Agency approval. Settlement addresses construction requirements for the road and requirements for construction of the single family dwelling specific to local approvals, on-site wastewater treatment system design, and outdoor lighting. Settlement also requires filing in the county clerk's office.
