5. Monthly Report of Enforcement Cases Settled:

Fifteen enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **June/July 2013** as follows:

SETTLEMENTS OF SUBDIVISION VIOLATIONS (9)

These settlements authorize the illegal lots involved in each case, allocate principal building rights, require a permit for future land use or development as appropriate, and require the filing of the settlement in the county clerk's office.

- Substandard Lot Subdivision (5)

OTHER VIOLATIONS (6)

E2013-0008, Ford and LaDuke(Black Brook, Clinton County)

• Establishment of an on-site wastewater treatment system absorption field within 100 feet of a wetland without a permit in 2011. Settlement requires upgrading the onsite wastewater treatment system upon replacement, failure, or increased occupancy of the single family dwelling on the property. Settlement requires payment of a \$250 civil penalty.

E2013-0024, F.R. Smith and Sons LLC, (Bolton, Warren County)

• Noncompliance with Agency Permit 87-342 related to storage of boats and requirement that permit be filed in the County Clerk's Office by November 23, 1993. Settlement Agreement requires storage of boats in compliance with the permit and filing of the Settlement Agreement with Agency Permit 87-342 attached.

E2013-0066, Toseland (Lake Luzerne, Warren County)

• Removal of more than 30 percent of the vegetation within six feet of the mean high water mark and more than 30 percent of the trees within 35 feet of the mean high water mark of Lake Luzerne in 2013 without a variance. Settlement requires stabilization of disturbed areas, tree planting, and payment of a \$650 civil penalty.

E2013-0082, Yanulavich, (Dannemora, Clinton County)

• Noncompliance with Settlement Agreement E2007-0362 relative to a retaining wall constructed within the shoreline setback of Chateaugay Lake in 2001 without a variance. Settlement Agreement requires implementation of an Agency-approved remediation plan.

2013-0030, Palmer, (Willsboro, Essex County)

• Placement of fill and a culvert in a wetland in 2013 to construct a driveway without a permit. Settlement Agreement requires remediation and payment of a \$250 civil penalty.

2007-0121, Wadhams, (Diana, Lewis County)

• Construction of a garage undertaken in 2007 within the shoreline setback of the Middle Branch of the Oswegatchie Scenic River without a variance. Settlement requires implementation of Agency-approved remediation plan and places restrictions on the removal of shoreline vegetation on the property.
