5. Monthly Report of Enforcement Cases Settled:

Five enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **August 2013** as follows:

SETTLEMENTS OF SUBDIVISION VIOLATIONS (2)

These settlements authorize the illegal lots involved in each case, allocate principal building rights, require a permit for future land use or development as appropriate, and require the filing of the settlement in the county clerk's office.

• Substandard Lot Subdivision (2) E2008-0341A, Rounds, (Warrensburg, Warren County) E2013-0115, 5163 Sagamore LLC, (Putnam, Washington County)

OTHER VIOLATIONS (3)

E2013-0105, Chakumanian (Dresden, Washington County)

• Construction of a garage located partially within the shoreline setback of Fairy Creek in 2013. Settlement requires implementation of Agency-approved plan for remediation and completion of construction.

E2012-0029, Cardinell (Parishville, St. Lawrence County)

• Lateral expansion of a pre-existing single family dwelling within the shoreline setback of Blake Falls Reservoir through construction of an attached screen house between 2011 and 2012. Settlement requires implementation of Agency-approved plan for removal of the screen house.

E2009-0181, Big Tupper Lake Marina, LLC (Tupper Lake, Franklin County)

• Lateral expansion of a pre-existing structure within the shoreline setback of Tupper Lake in 2009. Settlement requires implementation of an Agency-approved remediation plan and payment of a \$750 civil penalty.
