5. Monthly Report of Enforcement Cases Settled:

Two enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **September 2013** as follows:

E2013-0075, Mitchell (Schroon, Essex County)

• Construction of a hunting and fishing cabin greater than 500 square feet in size in a Resource Management land use area without the necessary permit in 2005. Settlement recognizes the structure as lawful, establishes requirements for the on-site wastewater treatment system, places restrictions on lighting, and requires filing in the county clerk's office.

E2013-0087, Iuliucci (Mayfield, Fulton County)

• Vegetative clearing and construction of an access road in noncompliance with Agency Permit 2007-261 in 2013. Settlement requires implementation of an Agency-approved plan for realignment of the access road and planting of vegetation. Settlement requires payment of a \$750 civil penalty.

E2013-0035, Fortuna (Fort Ann, Washington County)

• Removal of greater than 30% of the trees from within 35 feet of the mean high water mark of Hadlock Pond and removal of greater than 30% of the vegetation from within 6 feet of the mean high water mark of Hadlock Pond without a variance in 2013. Construction of a deck greater than 100 square feet in size within 50 feet of the mean high water mark of Hadlock Pond without a variance. Settlement requires implementation of an Agency-approved plan for re-planting and remediation of the structure as well as payment of a \$1,500 civil penalty.
