Meetings/Events/Teleconferences Attended

- 11/04/13. Subpoenaed to testify in a civil suit in relation to a 2006 Enforcement case. (Rooks)
- 11/6/13. Attended monthly Lake Champlain Basin Program Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) meeting. (Snizek)
- 11/7/13. Agency staff attended the NYS Invasive Species Council meeting. (Snizek) Topics of discussion included the following:
 - Prohibited and Regulated Invasive Species Proposed Regulation (6 NYCRR Part 575) is available for public review and comment. Public hearings have been scheduled for 4 sites beginning in December. Public comments will be accepted through December 23, 2013.
 - Invasive Species Advisory Committee updated the ISC members on 2014 education and outreach goals which includes: expanding the Adirondack IS awareness week to a single statewide invasive species awareness week (tentatively scheduled for 2nd week of July); developing a NYS invasive species branding campaign to include slogan and logo; secure funding for statewide IS public opinion poll; compiling an invasive species "bookshelf" an electronic clearinghouse containing all existing resources for public use.
 - Unconfirmed reports of hydrilla found near Croton and Hudson River. DEC still needs to confirm identification, but this would indicate that the range of hydrilla is expanding in NYS.
 - DEC advised that they have drafted regulations which will prohibit boats from entering or leaving a DEC launch with visible plants or animals on the boat and would also prohibit leaving a launch without draining the boat. A NYS transport law to prohibit the transport of IS is also in the works.

- 11/13/13. Meeting with DEC staff and consulting firm (Environment and Ecology, Inc.). Consultants are working with the towns of Keene and Jay developing a conceptual plan for flood response. Each town has received \$3 million as part of a NY Rising grant to assist a planning effort. (Lalonde)
- 11/13/13. Site visits scheduled with Town of Jay officials, DEC, Army Corps and NRCS to assess three Emergency Watershed Protection projects in the Town of Jay. One project is located at the Jay Covered Bridge in Jay. The other two are located along Styles Brook, which is further south along Route 9N. Damage occurred at these sites as a result of the Irene/Lee Hurricanes. Officials from the USDA-NRCS have compiled information concerning these sites in Damage Survey Reports. (Lalonde)
- 11/13/13. Meeting scheduled with Town of Willsboro officials and consultants to discuss Boquet River Non-Point Source Pollution Prevention Improvement Project. The project includes three alternatives to stabilize eroded shoreline on the River. (Lalonde)
- 11/14/13. Provided comments to the Adirondack Park Invasive Plant Program's Aquatic Invasive Committee regarding their draft white paper "Recommendations on the Utility of Inspection and Boat Decontamination as Components of an Integrated Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Strategy in the Adirondack Region". (Walrath, Snizek)
- 11/18/13. Participated in monthly Lake George Asian Clam Rapid Response Task Force Meeting by Telephone. (Walrath)
- 11/13/13. Proposed Municipal Beach in the Village of Tupper Lake. Discussed conceptual proposal with NYS Department of Health to construct a municipal beach at the Village Park on Raquette Pond in the hamlet of Tupper Lake. The Agency is currently reviewing a Jurisdictional Inquiry associated with the proposal. (Lalonde)
