• Construction of a boat launch site in 2013 within the designated Schroon River Recreational River Area without the necessary permit and variance. Settlement Agreement requires remediation of a strairway within the shoreline setback, vegetative plantings, places restrictions on future vegetation removal, requires reconfiguration of the entranceway to the site, and requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.

E2013-0119, Fortunato, (Stratford, Fulton County)

• Construction of a single family dwelling within the shoreline setback of the East Canada Creek in 2000 by a prior owner.
