Two enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreement executed in **October 2014** as follows:

SETTLEMENTS OF SUBDIVISION VIOLATIONS (1)

These settlements authorize the illegal lots involved in each case, allocate principal building rights, require a permit for future land use or development as appropriate, and require the filing of the settlement in the county clerk's office.

Other Violations (1)

E2014-0034 Warnot, (Schroon, Essex County)

• Construction of a garage located outside the shoreline setback of Paradox Lake in 2008 by a prior owner without a new or amended permit as required by Permit P2007-0098. Settlement recognizes garage as lawful, requires Agency approval prior to connecting the garage to a wastewater treatment system, and requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.
