The project is briefly described as follows: The variance request involves the construction of a two-story structure measuring 30 ft. by 40 ft. (1,200 sq. ft.) on the first level and 40 ft. by 20 ft. (800 sq. ft. roof) on the second level. The structure is proposed to be located in Arrowhead Park owned by the Town of Inlet. structure height measured from the highest point on the roof will be 28 ft. from the top of the existing boardwalk structure. The lower level of the structure will be used for temporary storage of canoes, kayaks and other water craft and the upper level will be utilized primarily for public events. The structure will be located at and within the mean high water mark of Fifth Lake Outlet and Fourth Lake.
