 Construction of a 112 square foot shed within 150 feet of the mean high water mark of the West Branch of the Ausable Recreational River since 2000. Settlement requires removal of the shed from within 150 feet of the mean high water mark of the West Branch of the Ausable Recreational River pursuant to an Agency-approved plan.
