5. Monthly Report of Enforcement Cases Settled:

Seven enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **June 2015** as follows:

SETTLEMENTS OF SUBDIVISION VIOLATIONS (5)

These settlements authorize the illegal lots involved in each case, allocate principal building rights, require a permit for future land use or development as appropriate, and require the filing of the settlement in the county clerk's office.

E2015-0026, Irish (Wells, Hamilton County) E2015-0034, Mast (Ellenburg, Clinton County)

SETTLEMENTS OF OTHER VIOLATIONS (2)

- E2012-0021B, Foster (Chazy, Clinton County)
 Further subdivision in 2004, through county tax foreclosure sale, of property authorized by Agency Permit P82-127AT. Settlement recognizes resulting lot as lawful, restricts lot to no principal buildings, and requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.
- E2013-0025, Higgins (Warrensburg, Warren County)
 Construction of a single family dwelling in a Resource Management
 Land Use Area in 2004. Settlement recognizes dwelling as lawful,
 requires a permit for any expansion, places restrictions on the
 wastewater treatment system, exterior lighting, color, and vegetation
 removal on the property. Settlement requires filing in the County Clerk's
 Office.
