One enforcement case was resolved by settlement agreement executed in **July 2015** as follows:

E2014-0172, McCann (Clifton, St. Lawrence County)
Replacement of a pre-existing boathouse in 2007 with a boat storage
building and attached deck greater than 100 square feet in size on
Cranberry Lake without the necessary variance. Settlement requires
reducing the deck to less than 100 square feet in size, replacement of
existing light fixtures on the building, and places restrictions on the color
and use of the building.
