5. Monthly Report of Enforcement Cases Settled:

Two enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **February 2016** as follows:

SETTLEMENT OF SUBDIVISION VIOLATIONS (1)

These settlements authorize the illegal lots involved in each case, allocate principal building rights, require a permit for future land use or development as appropriate, and require the filing of the settlement in the county clerk's office.

• RESOURCE MANAGEMENT SUBDIVISION (1)

E2016-0001A, Lutz, William H. & Janice R. (Clifton, St. Lawrence County)

SETTLEMENTS OF OTHER VIOLATIONS (1)

E2015-0170, Berlin (Chester, Warren County)

Construction of a single family dwelling, on-site wastewater treatment system, well in 2004, in locations other than what was approved by Permit 85-45. Construction of a driveway in noncompliance with Permit 85-45. Undertaking construction of a garage in 2015 that was not approved by Permit 85-45. Settlement recognizes single family dwelling, on-site wastewater treatment system, well, and garage as lawful. Settlement requires implementation of erosion controls related to construction of the garage, installation of a driveway culvert, and upgrading the wastewater treatment system upon replacement or failure. Settlement places restrictions on building colors, lighting, vegetation removal on the property, and requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.
