# RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE ADIRONDACK PARK AGENCY

## WITH RESPECT TO PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF GENERAL PERMIT 2014G-1B FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF TERRESTRIAL INVASIVE SPECIES IN OR POTENTIALLY IMPACTING WETLANDS IN THE ADIRONDACK PARK

#### October 8, 2020

#### WHEREAS.

- The proposed amended General Permit 2014G-1B titled "Management of Terrestrial Invasive Species in or Potentially Impacting Wetlands in the Adirondack Park" will:
  - a. be available for use throughout the Adirondack Park;
  - b. be effective from the date of issuance unless otherwise modified or revoked by the Agency;
  - c. authorize jurisdictional activities pursuant to Article 24 of the Environmental Conservation Law, §§ 809(2)(a) and 810(1) of the APA Act, and 9 NYCRR §§ 578.2(a), and 578.3(n)(2);
  - d. considering all the statutory and regulatory criteria for project approval as set forth in Executive Law §§ 809(10), ECL § 24-0801(2), and 9 NYCRR § 578.10, allow for the conditional undertaking of regulated wetland activities incidental to the management of terrestrial invasive species, and include relevant mitigating conditions, and conclusions of law;
- The proposed amended General Permit 2014G-1B will include procedures for persons to apply to be determined an Authorized User and included;
- 3. Pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(26) and section 572.23(d) of Agency regulations, issuance of the proposed amended General Permit 2014G-1B for "Management of Terrestrial Invasive Species in or Potentially Impacting Wetlands in the Adirondack Park" is a Type I action for purposes of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR), and the Agency has issued a negative declaration;

### BE IT RESOLVED,

- That the Deputy Director of Regulatory Programs is authorized to proceed to public comment on General Permit 2014G-1B "Management of Terrestrial Invasive Species in or Potentially Impacting Wetlands in the Adirondack Park;"
- 2. That the Deputy Director of Regulatory Programs is directed to provide notice of the proposed amended general permit, the Agency's SEQR negative declaration, and the opportunity for comment by the public for thirty days following publication in the ENB on the draft final order (attached) and the general permit and associated documents in accordance with 572.23(c).
